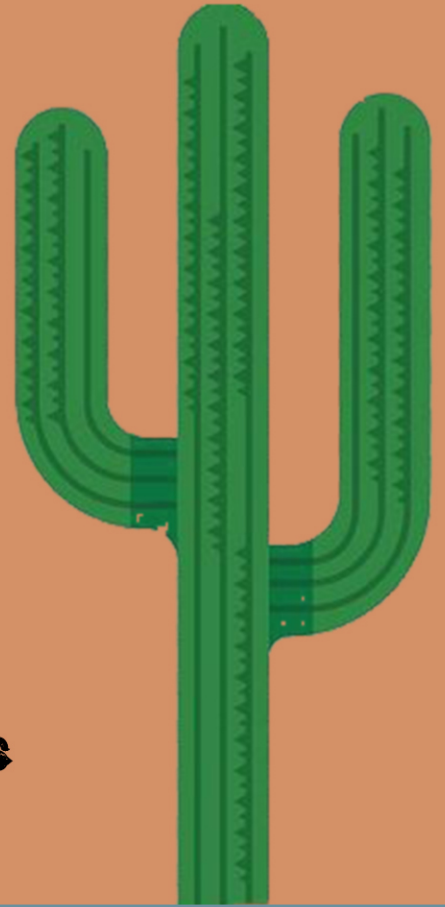

In this course, students will draw from critical scholarship and community memory practices, discussions, and community-focused assignments to develop an understanding of community-focused archives and museums as knowledge domains.

Students will be introduced to the concept of “research with respect” to develop practical strategies for working within community-focused archives and museum contexts to: identify records, artifacts, and their creation; document their activities; collect, manage, display, make accessible, and preserve records and other historical and cultural material.
